

MEMBERSHIP PROGRESS FLOW CHART

AUSTRALIAN STUDENT MEMBER

Masters Audiology or Diploma of Audiometry

Once completed: Contact the secretariat to upgrade to Associate Membership.

OVERSEAS AUDIOLOGIST – Min. Masters Audiology
OVERSEAS AUDIOMETRIST – Min. Diploma Audiology

Join via website - info required:
Academic Qualifications, transcripts, IELTS (or equiv.)

ASSOCIATE MEMBER (Provisional Audiologist/Audiometrist)

Once you have obtained employment your membership will be activated. Your internship can commence once your Supervisory Plan has been approved. *No clinical training can commence until then.*

LEVEL 1 – Week 1-4

Minimum Supervision required: 120hrs with 60hrs at elbow (min 30hrs/week)

(see Associate Supervision FAQ's for further details on Supervision requirements)

Once minimum requirements have been met, member submits documentation to the Secretariat for approval. Once approved the Associate is then able to progress to Level 2 Supervision

LEVEL 2 - Week 5-14

Minimum Supervision required: 150hrs with 75hrs at elbow/virtual (min 15hrs/week)

Apply to sit Mid Term Examination towards the end of L2

Once minimum requirements have been met and the Mid Term has been passed - Secretariat will approve progression to Level 3

MID TERM EXAM

Not required for AUS Audiologists

2nd and 3rd attempt allowed – must wait 30 days (continue to Log under L2 conditions)

If NYC on 3rd attempt- revert to AFFILIATE member

LEVEL 3 - Week 15-26+

Minimum Supervision required: 7.5hrs per week with supervisor

HRS Exam is sat once the full 26 weeks supervision is completed. This must be booked well in advance.

HRS EXAM

Not required for AUS Audiologists

2nd and 3rd attempts – must wait 3 months to re-sit (continue to Log under L3 conditions)

4th attempt – must wait 3 months to re-sit (revert to L2 conditions).
***Extra conditions apply*

If NYC on 4th attempt – revert to Affiliate Membership.

HRS COMPETENT – OVERSEAS AUDIOMETRIST

Upgraded to FULL Member – Apply for Qualified Practitioner number (QP) from HSP (Hearing Services Program)

HRS COMPETENT - OVERSEAS AUDIOLOGIST

Continue L3 supervision until the DRS exam has also been passed. Once passed - Upgraded to FULL member - Apply for Qualified Practitioner number (QP) from HSP (Hearing Services Program)

NB: If you sit and pass DRS, you will not need to sit/pass the HRS

DRS EXAM - Audiologists only

(Not required for AUS Audiologists)

Sat in April and October every year. Once DRS is passed, HRS Exam is not required.
